

- "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name", the anthem commissioned by the Harrisburg Chapter of the AGO Region III for the Region III Convention in 2011 composed by Robert Lau, was published by Paraclete Press.
- By August 24, 2014, our Chapter had provided 115 students with awards from the Shenk Scholarship Fund.
- Justin Myers, Pastoral Musician at St. Joseph Catholic Church of Mechanicsburg (and now Dean of our Chapter) joined the Guild in October of 2014.
- Alan Hair was honored in October of 2014 for his 30 years as organist of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Hershey. An organ composition was commissioned for the occasion from composer Dr. Robert Lau.
- Ross Ellison and Shawn Gingrich were presented in concerts at Millersburg University, Messiah College, and Bruton Parish in Williamsburg, VA as "Dueling Organists" in November of 2014.
